

Town of Pine Plains Town Board Meeting

June 20, 2024

The Town of Pine Plains Town Board convened for a regular schedule meeting at the Town Hall on the above date at 7 pm. Supervisor Brian Walsh, Councilman Robert Ambrose, Councilwoman Jeanine Sisco, Councilman Kevin Walsh, and Councilman Matthew Zick were present. Also in attendance was Attorney to the Town Warren Replansky, Highway Superintendent Carl Baden, PPWIA Ray Jurkowski Sergeant Michael Beliveau, Recreation Director Brian Coons, Planning Board Chairman/Zoning Review Committee Chair Michael Stabile and six members of the public.

Supervisor Walsh called the meeting to order, and the Pledge of Allegiance was done.

Councilman K. Walsh motioned to accept the May 2024 Town Clerks report, approve May 16, 2024, Town Board minutes, and June 17, 2024, workshop minutes second by Councilwoman Sisco 5-0 Passed.

Councilman Ambrose motioned to pay the following bills General Bills 20893-20945, Highway Bills 20946-20963, Water Bills 3289-3294, and Lighting District Bill 20892 and additional bill for 4H second by Councilwoman Sisco 5-0 Passed.

Public Comment- Sisco thanked the Garden Club, Highschoolers, Ms. Rhoades for planting the flowers in the barrels in town for Memorial Day. Also, to Thayer Durell for taking such good care of the barrels. Sisco also thanked Brian Walsh, Gregg Pulver and Robert Clinch for their hard work on the hometown hero banners. Frank Voltz- Wanted to know how long Woodward Hill Road was going to be closed for. Stan Hirson- Wanted an update on the website progress. Kim DeNardis- Wanted to know if the Board could do anything about the loud music at the Lions Club on the weekends. Laura Ferrell- Feels the Town should have a noise ordinance.

Department Reports- Highway- Highway Superintendent Carl Baden read report (on file).
Building Inspector- Report on file.

PPWIA/Engineer- Ray Jurkowski read PPWIA report (on file). The Town received 2 bids for the New Town Hall. At the workshop meeting July 15, the Board will meet with the architects and interview them.

Animal Control- Report on file.

Police Department- Sargeant Beliveau read report (on file).

Recreation-Recreation Director Brian Coons Read report (on file). Camp Director asked for approval of summer camp workers and pay scale, motioned by Ambrose to hire at pay rates second by Councilman Zick 5-0 Passed.

Zoning Review Committee- Michael Stabile let the Board know he will be putting out a survey on short term rentals in the Town. The survey will be available on the website, and Facebook. The ZRC will keep the survey open for a month. The Food Truck Law was discussed, the Board would like to add it to the Peddler Solicitation Law. CAC- Chairwoman Gail Mellow said the new committee had their first meeting on May 23 and all CAC members attended.

Old Business- Zick motioned to send out Community Center RFP and change date, second by Supervisor Walsh, 5-0 Passed. The Board discussed that the Beautification Committee should give suggestions on the recycling bins for the Town Center. The light at Patchins Mill and the

switch at community center will be looked at by Ginocchio Electric. Supervisor Walsh and Councilwoman Sisco are working on getting Pro Housing certified.

New Business- Zick motioned to approve Hannah Smith Schiller to the CAC, second by Ambrose 5-0 Passed. Sisco discussed Accessory Dwelling Grant. Sisco presented a new sign for the Community Center and the Library. The library would pay for the sign but is asking for the Board to approve payment for installation of the sign of \$695.00. The Board wants to see a survey map of the 7775 Main Street. The Board would like to talk with the Code Enforcement Officer and the Department of Transportation about the best place to put the new sign. Sisco asked about painting new parking lines at the municipal parking lot and the community center parking lot. Supervisor Walsh is going to try to get the same company that is painting the school's parking lots this summer. Community Day is in the planning stages for the fall. Zick discussed with the Board and Ray Jurkowski about the permit for sidewalks.

Zick motioned to adjourn, second by Ambrose 5-0 Passed.
