

Town of Pine Plains Town Board Meeting

February 9, 2026

The Town of Pine Plains Town Board convened for an emergency meeting at the Town Hall on the above date at 3 pm. Supervisor Brian Walsh, Councilwoman Sisco, Councilman Kevin Walsh Councilman Roush, and Councilwoman Murphy were present. Also in attendance were six members of the public.

Supervisor Walsh opened the meeting.

Supervisor Walsh for a motion to move into executive session to discuss contractual/personnel matters.

Councilman K. Walsh wanted to explain the topic of the meeting and would like it to live streamed.

Supervisor Walsh explained this executive session is to discuss the 3 Flock security cameras that were marked out to be installed. Walsh also discussed this matter with the Attorney to the Town Warren Replansky. Replansky wants the Town Board to discuss this matter in executive session. Councilwoman Sisco asked if Replansky will be available on the phone.

K. Walsh motioned to move into executive session to discuss Flock camera system, seconded by Councilman Roush, 4-0 passed. (Sisco abstained)

K. Walsh motioned to move back into regular session, seconded by Sisco 5-0 Passed.

Supervisor Walsh read a brief statement giving the history of the contact, and that as of February 3, 2026, the contract is null and void. This contract was not discussed with the Supervisor or the Town Board, which would have been proper protocol. In the future these policies and procedures will need to be enforced by every department.

K. Walsh stated how the entire Board worked together to gather information and remedied this situation.

Councilwoman Birdsall stated the Board couldn't meet sooner due to the laws for the Town Board how the can convene.
