

Town of Pine Plains Town Board Public Forum Meeting

March 10, 2026

The Town of Pine Plains Town Board convened for a special meeting at the Town Hall on the above date at 5 pm. Councilwoman Jeanine Sisco, Councilman Kevin Walsh, Councilman Trevor Roush and Councilwoman Murphy Birdsall. Supervisor Walsh was absent.

Interim Supervisor Murphy Birdsall opened the meeting to “AUTHORIZE THE SUBMISSION OF AN APPLICATION FOR A NYSDOT TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM (TAP) GRANT FOR PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE HAMLET OF PINE PLAINS AND AUTHORIZING THE TOWN SUPERVISOR TO EXECUTE ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION”

Sisco gave a brief update that Ray Jurkowski reworked the budget with a lower estimated cost of \$3,949,121.00 with a 20% price match from the Town at \$789,821.00. The Town will bond the monies needed for the match over the maximum years. The Town Board received letters of support from multiple townspeople, Chris Drago’s office and Didi Barrett’s office.
